Sample itinerary: One for the Heroes

Day One:

- Arrive in **PA's Laurel Highlands** to visit the Flight 93 National Memorial and the Que Creek Mine Rescue site. Both sites offer a haunting reminder of sacrifice, bravery, endurance, and hope.
- Head to **West Overton Village** to learn about local heroes of the past and have lunch while experiencing days gone by.
- Spend the night at the **Hampton Inn Greensburg** or **SpringHill Suites Monroeville** on your way to Pittsburgh.



Day Two:

- Breakfast at the hotel
- Enjoy a tour of the **Rivers of Steel's** Carry Blast Furnaces to learn about the everyday heroes who built the city of champions. Experience Pittsburgh's rich industrial history with a walking tour of the only remaining non-functional blast furnaces in the region.
- Have lunch at **Hofbrauhaus Pittsburgh** – Embrace the spirit of the mill workers by enjoying an ice-cold beer after your shift - tour.
- Visit the **Fort Pitt Museum** in the heart of downtown Pittsburgh, and then walk along Pittsburgh's North Shore, lined with monuments and statues honoring veterans of WWII, the Korean War, and the Vietnam War. Start your walk at Heinz Field, where a collection of monuments honor Law Enforcement, George Washington & Christopher Gist, and Pittsburgh's favorite neighbor, Mister Fred Rogers.
- Head up the mountain on the **Duquesne Incline** to take in this iconic vantage point of downtown Pittsburgh from Mount Washington.
- Enjoy dinner at **Gaetano's Catering and Event Center** before spending the night at one of our Greentree hotels.




Day Three:

- Drive up the Washington's Trail in **Butler County, PA**, taking in the sites and stops along the way. In 1753, 21-year-old George Washington took this route to deliver a letter demanding the French end occupation of the Western PA territory during the French & Indian War.
- Make your way to **Mercer County** for a guided tour of the Avenue of 444 Flags. The park was created in 1981 and a new flagpole was raised every day that the Iranian Hostage Crisis continued to honor the American diplomats held hostage in Tehran.
- End your afternoon with lunch and being the hero of savings at the **Grove City Premium Outlets**.
